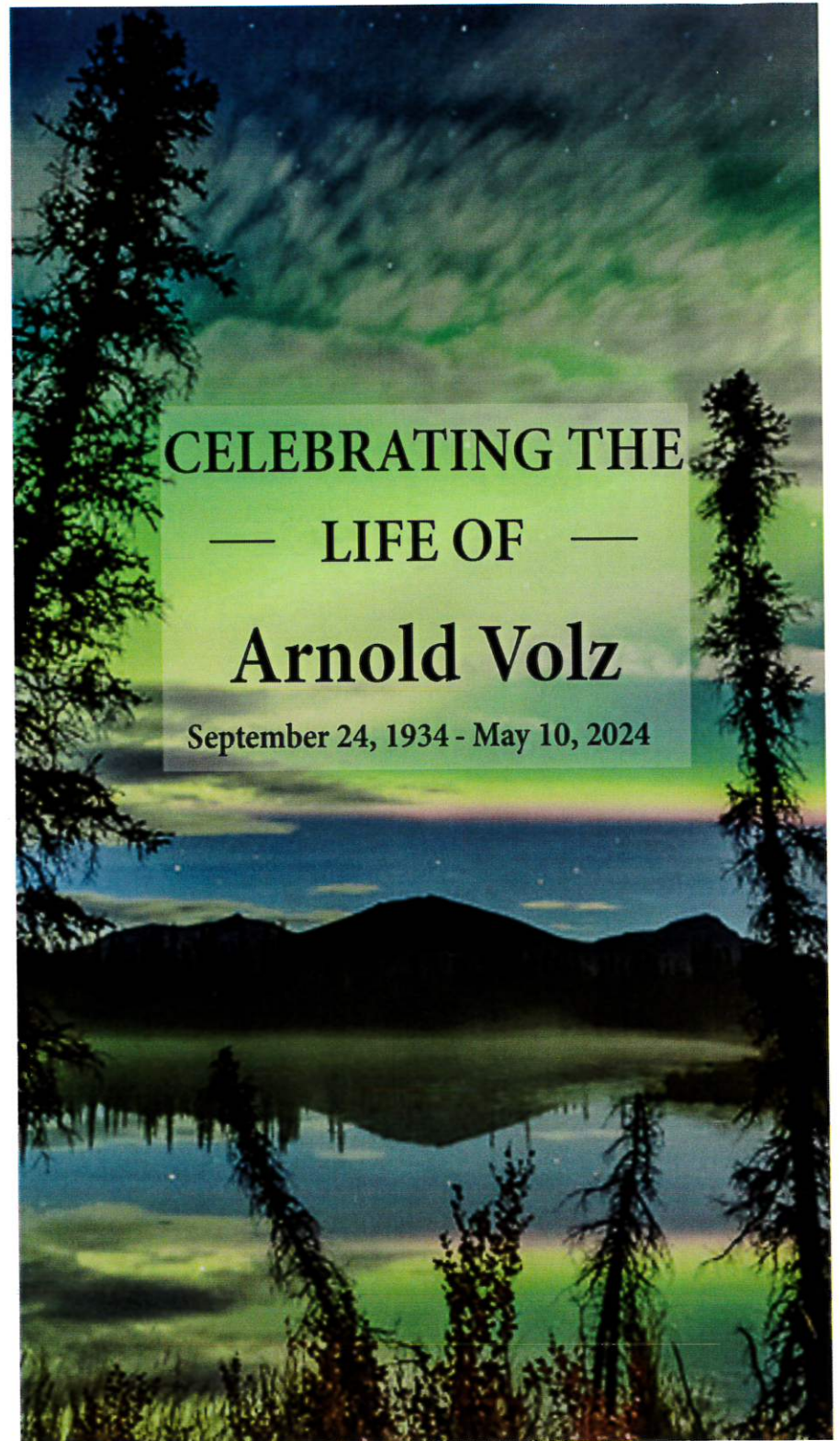


A Successful Man
